Rural Telehealth Certificate Program (RTCP): Professionals working in all areas of healthcare and especially in rural health care will engage in telehealth. The RTCP is designed to educate the next generation of rural health providers in telehealth. The innovative RTCP prepares professionals to provide telehealth services in rural, medically underserved areas, and to serve as leaders in improving quality and access to care for these patients.

Clinical Hours: Students will be assigned clinical supervising faculty (CSF) to support and guide their telehealth clinical experiences. The required 90 clinical hours of telehealth can be completed in a variety of telehealth clinical environments that align with student clinical interests.
